Pastor's Ponderings... "The Dash Makes All the Difference"

We love because God first loved us. Whoever claims to love God yet hates a brother or sister is a liar. For whoever does not love their brother and sister, whom they have seen, cannot love God, whom they have not seen. And he has given us this command: Anyone who loves God must also love their brother and sister. —1 John 4:19-21

I conducted a funeral on Wednesday for a woman who died of cancer. She was only 41. At the end of the celebration of her life and the life of Jesus in the midst of it all, I shared some final thoughts about life and death. Gravestones are engraved with the name of the person being remembered, with the date of birth and the date of death. But when you think about it, neither of those dates is nearly as important as the little tiny dash in between. The dash makes all the difference. And it really is a dash. It goes by so quickly, whether we live to be 41 or 81 or 101. Time is far too short to hold grudges, bitterness, and unforgiveness in our hearts. Sadly, the relationships that often carry the most hurt are the ones with our own family members. We open ourselves up more and are more vulnerable with our spouse, parents, children, brothers, and sisters than anyone else. Because the emotions are so close to the surface and so intense, often we are hurt more and cause more hurt with family than anyone else. Because of the deep wounds that come along in close relationships, many people go for very long periods of time—even years—not talking with the family members with whom the hurtful experience took place. The regret and guilt often is unbearable when one of the persons passes away, and the one left behind agonizes over why he or she never sought reconciliation.

Forgive. Try "I'm sorry I've held this resentment toward you for so long." It might go over better than, "I forgive you for what you did." Take responsibility for holding onto the hurt so long. It's not the other person's fault that you chose to continue being bitter.

Ask forgiveness. Apologize. Admit your mistake. Swallow your pride.

Tell your loved ones you love them—every day. Don't wait. Life goes by too quickly. It's a dash. And the dash makes all the difference.

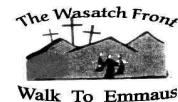

## REFLECTIONS

### THE SABBATH

In the creation story we are told that on the seventh day God rested, blessed it and made it holy. (Gen.2:3) In Exodus 23:12 God told the Israelites not to work on the Sabbath. The Hebrew word for Sabbath means to stop, to cease or desist.

In our busy, tumultuous world we find it harder and harder to stop. Demands on our time are so insistent that we find ourselves constantly on the go. A complaint often heard is, "there just isn't enough time." In fact what often defines us is what we do, not who we are. Another comment often heard is, "I find doing certain things helps me relax."

Have you ever stopped long enough to think we are too busy to be aware of God's gifts? We go on vacation -- the kids are watching DVDs in the backseat of the car. The wife/husband is reading a book. The driver is focusing on getting to the destination. All are missing out on the wonders of God's world the journey is taking them through. Even worse is the trip by plane; nothing is seen from the time of boarding to the time of arrival at the destination.

Could this be part of the reason we do not find reasons to be thankful? The concept of scarcity of time creates tunnel vision. The rush of everyday life pushes us to focus on our difficulties and the demands on our lives.

Maybe this is the message of the Sabbath. The Sabbath is God's gift to us, a time for rest, reflection, and time for family, a time to enjoy an unhurried meal, a time to visit with friends.

Jesus told us in Mark 2:27, "Man was not made for the Sabbath, the Sabbath was made for man." The Sabbath was not made to be a legalistic set of dos and don'ts. It was made so we would have a time, justification if you wish, to free up our schedules, a time in which we can experience God and His abundance, a time to refresh ourselves for the days to come.
