With the news that my father is suffering in the early stages of Alzheimer's, my family and I are devastated. But we have never felt alone in our grief. Continually, I have had member of my church family text me, call me, write notes and emails to me, and share their concern and love with me face-to-face, with kind words, hugs and shared tears.

I have often said, "Faith grows in community." Now I am learning in a very personal way that, in addition, healing happens in community. With your loved ones and friends, many of you have travelled before or are travelling now the road that I am just beginning. You remind me there is hope and help, and that by the grace of God, my family and I will get through this.

## Thank you for six wonderful years

To Our Supporters and Friends,

The Community Food Co-op will be ceasing operations after January. The Co-op has been distributing food now for six wonderful years. We have had many successes, including supporting local food producers and bringing low-cost, high-quality food to thousands of people in the region. We have been overwhelmed by the support we have received. We could not have managed this long without the dedication and enthusiasm of our members and volunteers.

We have happily worked side by side with all of you to see friendships built, communities strengthened, and of course families fed.

We are very proud of our accomplishments and have done everything in our power to make the Co-op viable. Despite our efforts, the project was not self-sustaining and we were relying on subsidies from our parent organization. This situation couldn't continue.

This decision was not easy. Everyone involved loves the project and desperately wanted to keep it going. However, after months of trying to figure a way to save the Co-op, the terrible truth had to be faced: the losses we were sustaining would begin to threaten the core mission of our parent organization.

- On February 1st, we will hold an open house and volunteer recognition event to celebrate the successes of the project and the many people who have made this possible.

We will publish one last Harvester Newsletter celebrating the accomplishments of the Co-op. It will be sent out with the January distribution, and will include a resource list to help you find the savings you need and the products you have come to love.

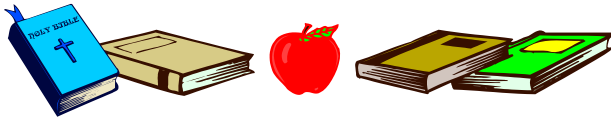

Hosting at Mtn Vista UMC March 4-11, June 24-July 1, 2012 & Sept 16-23, 2012.



Missions/Outreach Committee:

Wanted: "A few good men and women" to form four teams to help with hosting families with Family Promise for the year 2012. Four (4) teams are needed to help the program go more smoothly and efficiently for our 3 weeks of hosting this year. Reminder: Participation with the Family Promise program is a congregation-wide mission at Mountain Vista United Methodist Church.



VOLUNTEER RECRUITER: This team helps recruit volunteers. A good person (or persons) is someone who is friendly and understands the mission of Family Promise, so much that they will go up to people at church or make calls through the church directory. They may even provide reminder phone calls to the volunteers about when they are serving. (3-4 people)

SET-UP, TAKE-DOWN AND SUPPLIES: This team helps set-up the church for hosting and then take-down the program and clean when the families leave. They also would oversee the proper storage of all hosting items, and ensure that basic necessities such as toilet paper, toiletries, towels, sheets, etc. are in stock and available. This team will organize the laundering of the linens used for the week. For example, 2 or 3 volunteers each take home a bundle of linens, launder them and then return them to the church later. Reminder: For the purpose of restocking or purchasing needed supplies, funds can be collected from a congregational fund or donations. (3-4 people)

MEAL TEAM: This team helps organize the food supplies and meals for the week. They help plan menus or organize the meals to avoid duplication and ensure that meals are homemade and nutritious. They provide reminder calls to the meal volunteers and remind them of their assignment and delivery time. For breakfast and lunch supplies, this team needs to purchase through a congregation fund or donations. (3-4 people)
