### Pastor's Ponderings... "Wishing You a New Year's Christmas!"

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. **—John 1:14**

Do you have a lot of bills to pay off in the New Year after the holiday season? Christmas costs a lot, but often we only think in terms of what's left our wallets. Like the church bulletin misprint for one of the songs that was going to be shared in church at Christmastime: "I Heard the Bills on Christmas Morn." But because of Christ's example, God's Word shows us that the true cost of Christmas is not financial but relational. The Christmas message of the Bible demands that a great deal of time, effort, and emotional energy be poured into relationships. The gift of strong relationships is a gift that is not only to be shared among us at Christmastime, but ALL the time.

What kind of relationship cost will we incur in the New Year, 2012? Will we reconcile with someone we've hurt? Will we have a greater presence and influence in our child's life? Will we share openly with the friend who has no idea that there's a life of forgiveness through Jesus, ready and waiting for them? If we've just been on the fringes of our church family, will we invest ourselves in deeper Christian friendships?

Who in your world needs you to connect with them? With whom do you need to connect in 2012? Maybe it's an in-law, a parent, or your child. Maybe it's our church family.

Christmas is costly, and it's an investment to be made ALL YEAR LONG—not just financially, but relationally. The impact of what we buy with our money fades fast. Jesus' birth shows us that the cost and the impact of connecting relationally lasts forever.

## 2012 will bring exciting changes to Sunday mornings at Mountain Vista!

In an effort to provide more adult Sunday school options and to encourage adults to join in, effective **Sunday, January 8<sup>th</sup>**, we will adopt our **NEW** Sunday morning schedule of two worship services (note the time changes!!) with Sunday school in between. The schedule will be as follows:

**8:30 to 9:30** - Traditional Worship Service

**9:30 to 10:00** - Fellowship

**10:00 to 10:55** - Children's Sunday School and Angel Choir

**10:00 to 10:55** - Adult Sunday School (NOTE! The adult Sunday school classes will commence on January 15<sup>th</sup>.)

**11:00 to Noon** - Contemporary Worship Service (and Children's Church)

During the 11:00 am Worship Service, we will also offer Children's Church in the Fellowship Hall for children ages 4 through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Children in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and older are encouraged to join us in worship. We will need two volunteers each Sunday to cover Children's Church.

It is also hoped that by providing an extended time of Fellowship, we will encourage the people from both services to spend that time together so that we may truly be ONE congregation.

On January 8<sup>th</sup>, during our fellowship time, the adult Sunday school leaders will be available in the fellowship hall to provide information on the classes being offered and to enroll those adults interested in joining. At this time, here is what is planned for our adults:

- Bob P will continue to lead his class on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians. This class is based upon the commentaries of Dr. William Barclay, Dr. J Vernon McGee, Chuck Swindol, and Matthew Henry. This is a lecture style class with everyone receiving notes prior to the class by e-mail. The class discusses important points and questions and concerns are addressed. The historical, economic, and political environments of the era are discussed to provide content and Bob will occasionally diverge to research a subject which the class finds interesting or pertinent to our times. The class is currently still studying 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians and they will continue to June, moving on to 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians. Bob plans to continue the class next September. *This class meets in the large Sunday school room in the original building.*
- Pastor Steve and Ron G will lead **Honor Begins at Home**, a men's Bible study based on the film, **Courageous**. Study material for the class will not be available until mid-January, so there will be a related Bible study for the first week or two. The Courageous men's Bible study is an 8-week course and will take men deeper into biblical truths for a godly family by using clips from the **Courageous** movie to help group members engage in discussion. The study also includes daily readings from **The Resolution** to help individuals better connect with God. *Meeting in the Sanctuary building Kitchen.*
- There will also be a women's Sunday school class. Leader(s), format, overview, and *meeting location to be announced.*
- Dave S will lead a class on Spiritual Gifts, *meeting in the Sanctuary.*
- Two other adult classes will be offered by Steve and Jenny S; one for men and one for women. Information and support for technological temptation for men and information and emotional support for women. *These classes will be held at a local coffee shop or some other venue "off campus."*

## Happy New Year!

Throughout the month of December we explored the concept of stewardship and generosity. A steward is a caretaker. Simply put, stewardship is what we do with what we have. Stewardship embodies the concepts of love, compassion, charity, generosity and finally, wholeness. That is why we focus on all parts of the Christian body – prayers, presence, gifts, service and Christian witness. The whole body works together to fulfill God's purposes here on earth.

And I see examples of generosity all around me in this church family. I am inspired by all of you. We have a wonderful music team that shares their talents at our 4 worship services each week. Thank you for the joy you shower on us. We are so blessed by you all.

We have a group of persons who love our children and give generously to nurture their faith and love of Christ each week in Sunday school classes and youth activities. Thank you.

We have an army of quiet disciples who go about the business of cleaning and maintaining this house of God so that we have a place to gather. Thank you for serving even when you're tired.

We have a special group of persons who practice hospitality at every turn with a smile and a hug – letting all who enter our doors that they are welcome here. Thank you for sharing your love.

We have a group of radical social activists that walk in Jesus' steps by daring to face the homeless, the hungry and isolated people in our world without prejudice. Thank you for your courage to step out of your comfort zone.

We have a beloved Pastor who tends to this rag, tag bunch of flawed people that often times expect too much of him. Thank you, Pastor Steve, for leading us, challenging us, nudging us, loving us and humbly doing your best day in and day out.

And lastly, we have about 70 persons and families that give regularly with their tithes and offerings to financially support all the ministries of our church. Our budget is about \$250,000 a year and that works out to about \$300 a month for each of them. Thank you for your faithful generosity.

By re-committing each year, we are renewing our covenant with God to be stewards of His creation. For me, I find it helpful to write down my intentions for the coming year. Of course, God doesn't need our commitment cards, but they do help the Ad Council and Finance committee as they plan for the year ahead. If you have not had an opportunity to complete one or all of the commitment cards, I encourage you to do so. There are extras on the table outside the sanctuary doors. There are many ways to live out your faith through your prayers, presence, gifts, service and Christian witness. I look forward to serving with you in the year to come!
