And all who have been united in Christ in baptism have put on Christ, like putting on new clothes.</b></p>
<p>Session 3:</p> <p>Sharing The Secret</p>	
<p><b>Jesus Christ – Only source for personal salvation</b></p>	<p>God’s Grace:  Ephesians 2: 5  That even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead. (It is only by God’s grace that you have been saved!).</p>
<p><b>Love Never Fails</b></p>	<p>1 Corinthians 13:8: Prophecy and speaking in unknown languages and special knowledge will become useless. But love will last forever!</p>
<p><b>One body, one spirit, one race.</b></p>	<p>Nothing can separate us from the love of God.</p>
<p><b>Making the story known is the responsibility of each disciple, regardless of personal circumstances.</b></p>	<p>Romans 15: 27  They were glad to do this because they feel they owe a real debt to them. Since the Gentiles received the spiritual blessings of the Good News from the believers in Jerusalem, they feel the least they can do in return is to help them financially.</p>
<p><b>God’s Plan</b></p>	<p>Ephesians 3:  Verse 6: And this is God’s plan: Both Gentiles and Jews who believe the Good News share equally in the riches inherited by God’s children. Both are part of the same body, and both enjoy the promise of blessings because they belong to Christ Jesus.</p> <p>Verse 7: By God’s grace and mighty power, I have been given the privilege of spreading this Good News.</p> <p>Verse 10: God’s purpose in all this was to use the church to display his wisdom in its rich variety to all the unseen rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.</p> <p>Verse 11: This was his eternal plan which he carried out through Christ Jesus our Lord.</p> <p>Verse 12: Because of Christ and our faith in him we can now come boldly and confidently into God’s presence.</p>
